



GENERAL RENTAL CONDITIONS OF THE TRACK

THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE QUOTATION FOR RENTAL IMPLIES THE FOLLOWING CLAUSES

1. THE CONTRACTOR does hereby declare that he/she has rented the premises of the Circuito del Motor y Promoción Deportiva S.A. (THE CIRCUIT) in order to carry out activities related to this offer.
2. This rental contract allows the use of the premises and areas at the CIRCUIT for the activities specifically contracted and with the relevant price quotations. The services, material and infrastructures not covered under the conditions of this contract will require a separate annex to the contract with authorisation in writing by the CIRCUIT.
3. Unless the premises have been rented with the inclusion of an exclusivity clause, the CIRCUIT reserves the right to allow more than one simultaneous activity provided that they are compatible. If, due to organisational causes by the CIRCUIT, it were not possible to carry out the contracted activities on the foreseen date, the CIRCUIT shall be obliged to fully refund the amount received or to postpone the date to another date for the CONTRACTOR to carry out the contracted activity.
4. The CONTRACTOR shall be liable for any damages, either material or personal, caused on the premises of the CIRCUIT provided that the damages in question are attributable to the activities carried out by the aforementioned CONTRACTOR.
5. The CONTRACTOR does hereby declare to have full knowledge that the activities organised involve risks and danger to those who carry them out. Likewise, he/she is aware of the safety measures at the circuit to provide assistance for these activities which have been personally applied for and contracted. He/She does hereby voluntarily accept each and every one of the risks involved in the activities in question and ratifies this statement by undersigning this contract.
6. The CONTRACTOR does hereby declare to have contracted the necessary insurance policies to comply with the legal requirements in order to carry out the contracted activities, including an insurance policy for civil liability that covers damages to third parties. Likewise, the racers and the rest of the personnel who take part in the activities must have an accident insurance policy for any possible injuries they may suffer during the activities. Any injuries suffered by this personnel will be the liability of the CONTRACTOR. The CIRCUIT reserves the right to demand copies of the insurance policies.
7. In the event of the weather or technical conditions or those of any other nature, giving rise to the suspension of the contracted activities, under the CIRCUIT'S criterion, the CONTRACTOR will be exempt of payment for the contracted services. In the event of there being a temporary suspension of activities, under the CIRCUIT'S criterion, and because of this there is less use of the track both in number of vehicles and in the amount of time spent on the track, the quotation will be modified according to the use the CONTRACTOR has had of the track. If, on the other hand, the weather and technical conditions or those of any other nature are deemed suitable by the CIRCUIT for the contracted activities, and in spite of this, the activities are not carried out due to reasons attributable to the CONTRACTOR, the latter will be obliged to pay in full for the contracted services.
8. The CONTRACTOR does hereby declare that during the use of the CIRCUIT'S premises, the activities organised are under his/her own risk and responsibility. Therefore, he/she does hereby relinquish the right to any claims for damages derived from the use of the CIRCUIT'S premises, as do the racers who take part in the activities and any other legal representative. They also relinquish the right to any other penal or civil action, contractual or extra-contractual liability that they may wish to take out against the CIRCUIT, its employees or people who provide services to the CIRCUIT.
9. The areas reserved for fitting advertising banners, etc., will be returned to the circuit in the same state of availability as they were handed over to the CONTRACTOR. Therefore, it is the responsibility of the CONTRACTOR to remove any advertising material that is placed on or in the premises of the CIRCUIT. In the event of this not being carried out and it being the CIRCUIT who has to remove the advertising, the costs incurred through the work involved in this take will be invoiced as an annex service to the quotation.
